# The 2017 Elmwood Giant Development Tournament 15U

#### **Tournament Rules**

### This is a Wood Bat Tournament

- 1 The Home Team will be responsible for supplying the Baseballs.
- 2 The second named team is the Home Team.
- The Home Team is the official scorer for each game and will be responsible for reporting the score to the Results Chairman at each site.
- 4 Games are 7 innings long. Games will not end in a tie. All games will be played until a winner is decided. Games suspended due to weather or darkness will be considered complete if 5 innings have been played.
- The Baseball Canada extra inning procedures will apply. Each team will begin the extra inning and every subsequent inning with a player on first and second with no outs. The batting order in the extra inning will be determined by how the previous inning ended. The last batter of the previous inning shall be placed on first and the second last batter will be placed on second.
- 6 An eight (8) run mercy rule is in effect after 5 innings.
- 7 Designated Hitter Rule is in effect for the pitcher only.
- 8 Pitch counts are not being recorded. Pitch counts are a safety measure. Teams are expected to follow their own league rules on pitching limitations.
- 9 The Re-entry Rule is not in effect.
- 10 Courtesy Runner for the catcher with 2 out (mandatory).
- Injury Rule In situations where an injury occurs to a player, and all other players are ineligible to enter the game, the last player leaving the game may re-enter to replace the injured player. The replacement must bat in the injured player's spot in the batting order. The injured player may not re-enter the game.
- 12 Tie Breaking Rule will be as follows:
  - a) Game results between the tied teams.
  - b) Runs allowed divided by defensive innings in games between the tied teams.
  - c) Runs scored divided by offensive innings in games between the tied teams.
  - d) Coin flip
- 13 Protests must be dealt with on the spot. Umpires decisions will be final.
- 14 The tournament Site Chairman has the power to amend the draw due to major weather disruption.
- 15 Each Team will be allowed to warm up on the playing field only once per day and only if time permits. Teams should warm up prior to their first game on the main diamonds. Subsequently they should warm up on adjacent fields.
- 16 All other Baseball Canada Rules will apply.
