1	The Home Team will be responsible for supplying the Baseballs.							
2	The second named team is the Home Team.							
3	The Home Team is the official scorer for each game and will be responsible for reporting							
	the score to the Results Chairman at each site.							
4	Games are 7 innings long. Games will not end in a tie. All games will be played until a							
	winner is decided. Games suspended due to weather or darkness will be considered							
	complete if 5 innings have been played.							
5	The Baseball Canada extra inning procedures will apply. Each team will begin the extra							
	inning and every subsequent inning with a player on first and second with no outs. The batting							
	order in the extra inning will be determined by how the previous inning ended. The last batte							
	of the previous inning shall be placed on first and the second last batter will be placed on							
	second.							
6	An eight (8) run mercy rule is in effect after 5 innings.							
7	Designated Hitter Rule is in effect for the pitcher only.							
8	Pitch counts are not being recorded. Pitch counts are a safety measure. Teams are							
	expected to follow their own league rules on pitching limitations.
