



Grassroots Development Clinics



Cost of Clinics

- Baseball Sask will calculate a quote for the cost of each clinic based on the location, travel required, number of sessions, number of players, number of instructors needed, etc.
- All costs must be agreed upon prior to confirming a date for the clinics.

Scheduling Guidelines

- Contact Nolan Bracken at Baseball Sask for available dates and to confirm a date for the clinic (nolan@baseballsask.ca or 306-780-9222).
- Available dates are booked on a first come – first serve basis.
- To be eligible to host a Grassroots Development Clinic ALL players and coaches must be registered members of Baseball Sask.
- As the host for the clinic you will be responsible for the registration process to collect registrations from players in your community.
- Each clinic is set for a maximum of 15 players. Additional sessions can be added to accommodate more registrations.
- EACH SESSION REQUIRES THE ATTENDANCE OF COACHES! Coaches are vital to the success of the Grassroots Development programs as they are responsible for running the program in your community following the clinics.
- As the host for the clinic you will be responsible for booking a facility for the clinic and any costs associated with booking the facility.
- Following the clinics you will receive an invoice in the mail from Baseball Sask. Payment must be submitted within 30 days.

Membership Assistance Program (MAP)

- If you host a Grassroots Development Clinic your association is eligible to apply for a MAP Grant to help cover the cost of the clinics.
